The Youth Leader reports to Church and Ministry Committee.

Responsibilities and Duties

Foster fellowship, spiritual growth and discipleship by developing and leading a consistent calendar of youth events, including, but not limited to youth group meetings, service projects, Sunday youth services, and retreats.

Enhance a church - youth connection by managing and maintaining a social media presence (i.e. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram etc.)
